Kenny Scharf created his first tondo paintings in the 1980s. In 2019 he painted “LOOKY” for his landmark immersive *Universalis* exhibition at La Nave Salinas, Ibiza.

The round form makes the screenprint look like a bubble hung on the wall. It also reminds the shape of an emoji to highlight emotions and express a special happy mood.
